## USE OF ECONOMIC ANALYSIS IN TRANSPORTATION PROJECT SELECTION

2016 TRB ANNUAL MEETING

The TRB Transportation Economics Committee (ABE20) invites all interested parties to submit applications for a poster session display at the TRB Annual Meeting in Washington, DC. This session will provide a unique opportunity to share with an international audience your experience in using economic analysis to help with transportation project selection.

### Poster Session Purpose

The Poster Session is designed to highlight how economic analysis (such as benefit cost analysis, life cycle cost analysis, etc.) was used to help with project selection. The objective is to share and discuss research findings and case studies that identify best practices, examine use of techniques to evaluate difficult concepts (such as livability), and promote the use of economic analysis in the decision making process. This could be for the selection of a specific project, choosing among alternatives, selecting multiple projects as part of a program, or all of the above.
